



2020 Master State Team Selection Format

1.1 Masters

The WA Masters State Team will comprise of:

- Winner of the Masters State Singles Championship
- Top 5 highest frame winning players after Masters State Team Trial

Eligibility

Any man or woman who is fifty (50) years of age or over prior to the State Master's Team Trials.

Players must play 33 1/3% of a season for Perth Pool Leagues or Affiliated Country Association leagues

- The fee of this event will be stipulated by the WAEBF Board and is \$220, including individual membership fee of \$55.
- No late payments of the fee will be accepted.

Format

The event will be held over one full Saturday and Sunday. The event is a round robin event, two (2) frames against all players, alternating breaks, one (1) point per frame will be awarded for every frame won.

If the playing field is too large to complete on a Saturday then the round robin will continue through to the Sunday.

The remaining five (5) positions are determined by the five (5) players in the standings of most won frames.

Each player will be awarded a State Team Acceptance letter to be used for important information notice and government funding/grants.
