



2020 State Men's Team Selection Format

Mens

The WA Men's State Team will consist of:

- State Men's Single Winner
- Super League Gold Medal Winner
- State Team Play Off
- The Board may issue a wildcard into the State Team if it deems necessary

Eligibility

To represent the WA State Team, players must compete in 33% of available frames in an affiliated WAEBF league competition (unless The Board approves otherwise).

All athletes must sign the Code of Conduct and be financial with the WAEBF. Any player that is un-financial will be prohibited from competing.

- The fee of this event will be stipulated by the WAEBF Board.
- No late payments of the fee will be accepted.

Dress Standard – Long Pants (or dress jeans), closed shoes, and a neat collared shirt.

State Men's Singles

The State Men's Singles event is open to any player in WA. The criteria of any player entering the competition is that they must have no outstanding fees owing to the WAEBF and their primary residence is within WA.

The format of the event is a seeded knockout. The seeds are determined by the tournament director of the event.

The winner of the event is granted an automatic spot in the Men's State Team

Super League Gold Medal

Super League is the most elite league ran in WA. It consists of team's competing against other teams in a round robin. There is no maximum of what the highest grading point player can be to compete, however there is a minimum grading points of what a team must meet. The single statistics are updated after each team round of super league. The gold medal is awarded to the player who has played a minimum of 75% of available frames (to make the individual eligible for state team requirements) and has the highest percentage after the last round of super league. Finals of super league will not contribute to the percentages of single statistics.

State Team Qualifying Event

All players who are not automatically qualified for the State Team Playoff are eligible to play in the State Team Qualifier.

- The cost will be \$55 Membership Fee (if not a member already) plus \$33 tournament fee
- All players will play a two (2) full one (1) frame round robins (alternate break) with all wins tallied
- Players will be notified prior to this event of how many players will qualify for the State team Playoff
- There will be a minimum of six (6) player qualify for the State Team Playoff

State Team Playoff

The State Team Playoff will consist of the following players:

- The Winner and Runner Up from the **2019 Country Week Singles**
- The Highest percentage (%) and Runner Up percentage (%) from first (1st) **Division 2019 Country Week**, plus any ties (if any player/s choose not to attend the playoff, the places will be offered to the person/s next on the list)
- Six (6) country representatives, one (1) from Peel, Bunbury, Great Southern, Goldfields, Midwest and North-West Associations
- Position second to tenth (2nd-10th) from after **Round 2 Super League**, plus any ties (if any player/s choose not to attend the playoff, the places will be offered to the person/s next on the list)
- Runner Up from the **2020 State Men's Singles**
- Semi Finalists from **2020 State Men's Singles**
- A wildcard player/s should the WAEBF Board deem necessary
- All remaining position will be filled by the State Team Qualifying event.

Format of the State Team Playoffs

- The State Team Playoff will consist of twenty eight (28) players.
- The cost will be \$55 membership (if not already a member) plus \$165 tournament fee

Weekend 1:

The twenty eight (28) players will play a one (1) frame full round robin on the Saturday and a one (1) frame full round robin on the Sunday (alternate break from previous day).

All wins are tallied. The top twenty (20) players (plus any ties) will proceed to the second (2nd) week of the playoffs

All wins carry through to the second (2nd) week.

Weekend 2:

The remaining twenty (20) players will play two (2) one frame full round robins on the Saturday (alternate break).

The top twelve (12), plus any ties will play on the Sunday and play another two (2) one (1) frame round robins.

At the conclusion all wins over the two (2) weekend will be tallied and the remaining positions will be filled in the WA Men's State Team.

Should the State Men's Singles Winner and or the Super League Gold Medal Winner choose not to be in the team, the additional player position will come from the Playoffs.

The WAEBF Board will adjust the number of players in the State Team Playoff if it deems necessary.

All positions must be played out, if there are any ties a playoff will commence to determine a final list of the last twelve (12) players.

Should a player pull out before the final Sunday, the position will be given to the player who was next in line of the State Team Playoff.

If a player does not turn up or leaves before the round robin is completed, all frames against that player, including those already played will become byes. If a full round robin is completed the wins/losses will stand.

Each player will be awarded a State Team Acceptance letter to be used for important information notice and government funding/grants.
