



2020 State Women's Team Selection Format

Women

The WA Women State Team will be selected by the following events:

- Winner of State Women Singles
- Top 6 standings from State Team Qualifying Event

State Women's Singles

The State Women's Singles event is open to any player in WA. The criteria of any player entering the competition is that they must have no outstanding fees owing to the WAEBF and their primary residence is within WA.

The format of the event is a seeded knockout. The seeds are determined by the tournament director of the event.

The winner of the event is granted an automatic spot in the Women's State Team

Eligibility

Women who are interested in making the State Team have four (4) fields of making it through to the State Team Qualifying Event.

1. Previous years state team (7) that travelled
2. Winner, Runner Up, and both semi-finalists in **2019 Country Week Women Singles**
3. All remaining positions will be filled by State Team Playoff
4. The WAEBF Board may issue a wildcard if deemed necessary

To represent the WA State Team, players must compete in 33.33% of available frames in an affiliated club/league (unless The Board approves otherwise).

All athletes must sign the Code of Conduct and be financial with the WAEBF. Any player that is un-financial will be prohibited from competing.

- The fee of this event will be stipulated by the WAEBF Board.
- No late payments of the fee will be accepted.

Women must choose to play in the Men's or the Women's selection system. They cannot attempt both.

Dress Standard – Long Pants (or dress jeans), closed shoes, and a neat collared shirt

State Team Playoff – Format

The cost will be \$55 membership (if not already a member) plus \$165 tournament fee.

The event will be conducted over one full Saturday and Sunday. The Saturday will run as a round robin tournament, two (2) frames against all players. One (1) point awarded for every frame won. After all players

have played each other the points will be tallied and the top twelve (12) will proceed to the Sunday. The results obtained on the Saturday will carry forward to the Sunday for the top twelve (12) qualifying players. Any tied positions will be played off to determine the outright standings.

The Sunday will be a round robin, two (2) rounds of one (1) frame played against all players. One (1) point will be awarded for each win. At the end of the event, the results are tallied, combining Saturday and Sunday results. The top six (6) players in the standings are the remaining players in the state team. Any tied positions will be played off to determine the outright standings.

If a player does not turn up or leaves before a round robin is completed, all frames against that player, including those already played, will become byes.

Should the State Women's Singles Winner choose not to travel the additional player position will come from the playoffs

Each player will be awarded a State Team Acceptance letter to be used for important information notice and government funding/grants.

Result of a draw after the event

If a draw between two (2) or more players has been determined after the State Team Playoff then the two players will be contacted of the draw.

For players who live 50km from WAEBF Head Quarters will be required to travel to Head Quarters and play out the draw with the winning player achieving that position in the line-up. If any one or both players

live outside the 50km radius then a count back of who won the most games against those two drawn players over both Saturday and Sunday, with the player who won the most frames against the other drawn player achieving that position in the line-up. If by the end of the count back the players are still drawn then the WAEBF Board will decide who out of the drawn players will be rewarded with the position in the line-up.

2020 Women's State Team Selection The Women's State Team will consist of:

The State Women's Singles Winner

The Board may issue a wildcard into the State Team if it deems necessary

All remaining players will come from the State Team Playoff.

7 players in total will be in the WA Women's State Team.

The State Team Playoff will consist of the following players:

The current Women's State Team (that travelled)

The Winner, Runner up and Semi Finalists from the Women's Country Week Singles from 2019.

A wildcard player/s should The Board deem necessary

All remaining positions will be filled by the State Team Qualifying event.

Format of the State Team Playoffs:

The State Team Playoff will consist of 16 players (see notes)

The Cost will be \$55 membership (if not already a member) plus \$165 tournament fee

The 16 players will play 2 one frame full round robins on the Saturday (alternate break)

All Wins are tallied. The top 12 players (plus any ties) will proceed to the 2nd day of the playoffs

The remaining 12 players (plus any ties) will play another 2 one frame full round robins on the Sunday (alternate break).

At the conclusion ALL wins over the 2 days will be tallied and the remaining positions will be filled in the WA Women's State Team Please Note:

This Board will adjust the number players in the State Team Playoff if it deems necessary.

All positions must be played out, if there any ties there will be playoffs to finish with a final position list of all players in the last 12 ➤

Should a player pull out before the final Sunday the position will be given to the player who was next in line ➤

If a player does not turn up or leaves before a round robin is completed, all frames against that player, including those already played, will become byes. If a full round robin is completed the wins/losses will stand. ➤

Dress Standard – Long Pants (or dress jeans), closed shoes, and a neat collared shirt ➤

Should the State Women's Singles Winner choose not to travel the additional player position will come from the playoffs ➤

To represent the WA State Team, players must compete in 33% of available frames in a league competition in a Federation or Associated League (unless The Board approves otherwise) State Team Playoff Qualifying Event All players who are not automatically qualified for the State Team Playoff are eligible to play in the State Team Playoff Qualifier. ➤

The cost will be \$55 Membership Fee (if not a member already) plus \$33 tournament fee ➤

All players will play 2 full one frame round robins (alternate break) with all wins tallied ➤

Players will be notified prior to this event of how many players will qualify the State Team Playoff. ➤

There will be a minimum of 6 players qualify for the State Team Playoff NB Women must choose to play in the Men's or the Women's selection system. They cannot try out for both.
